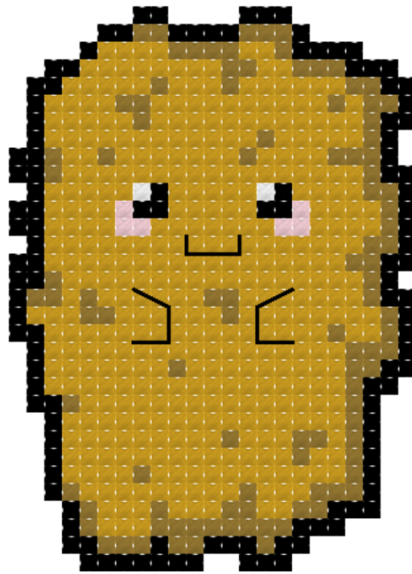

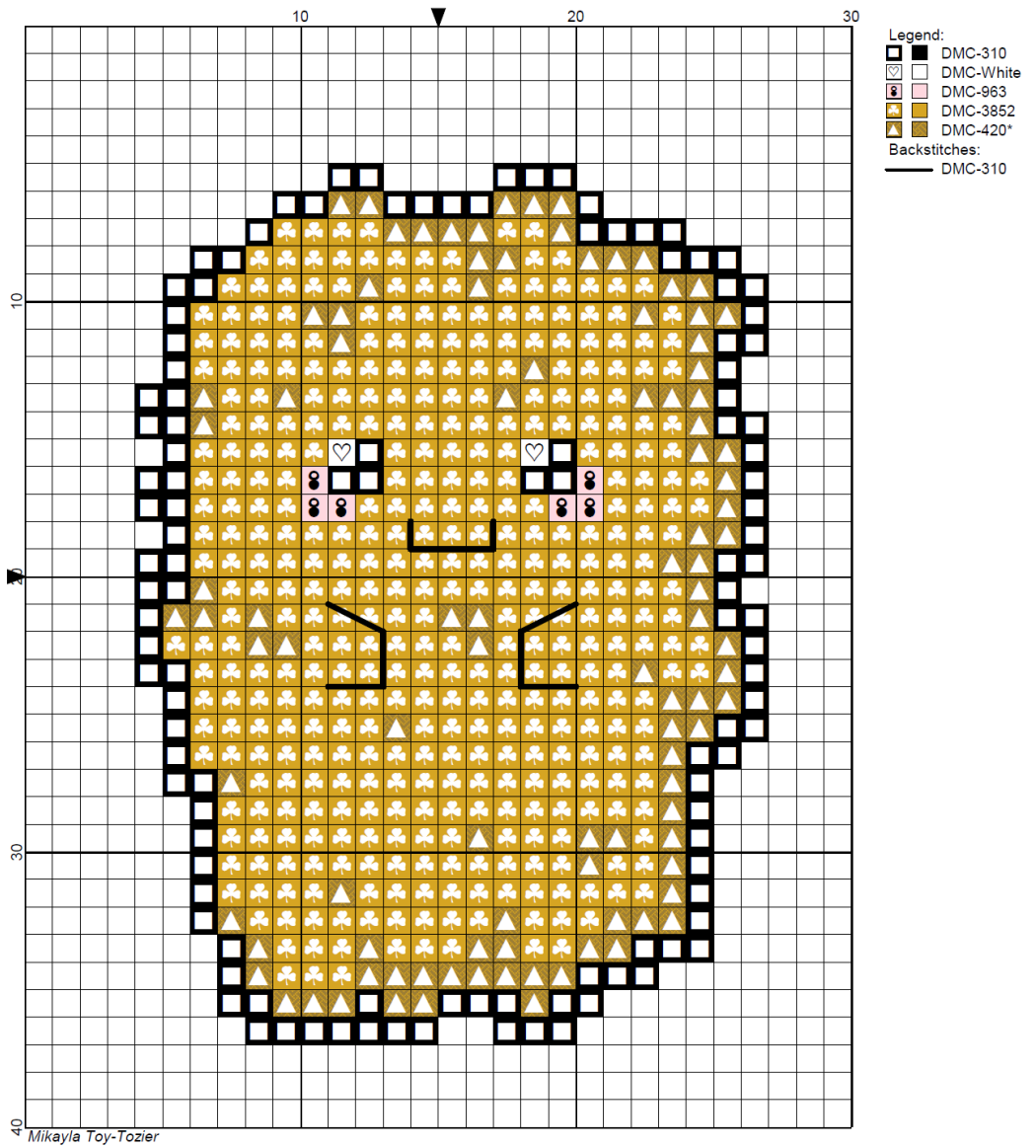

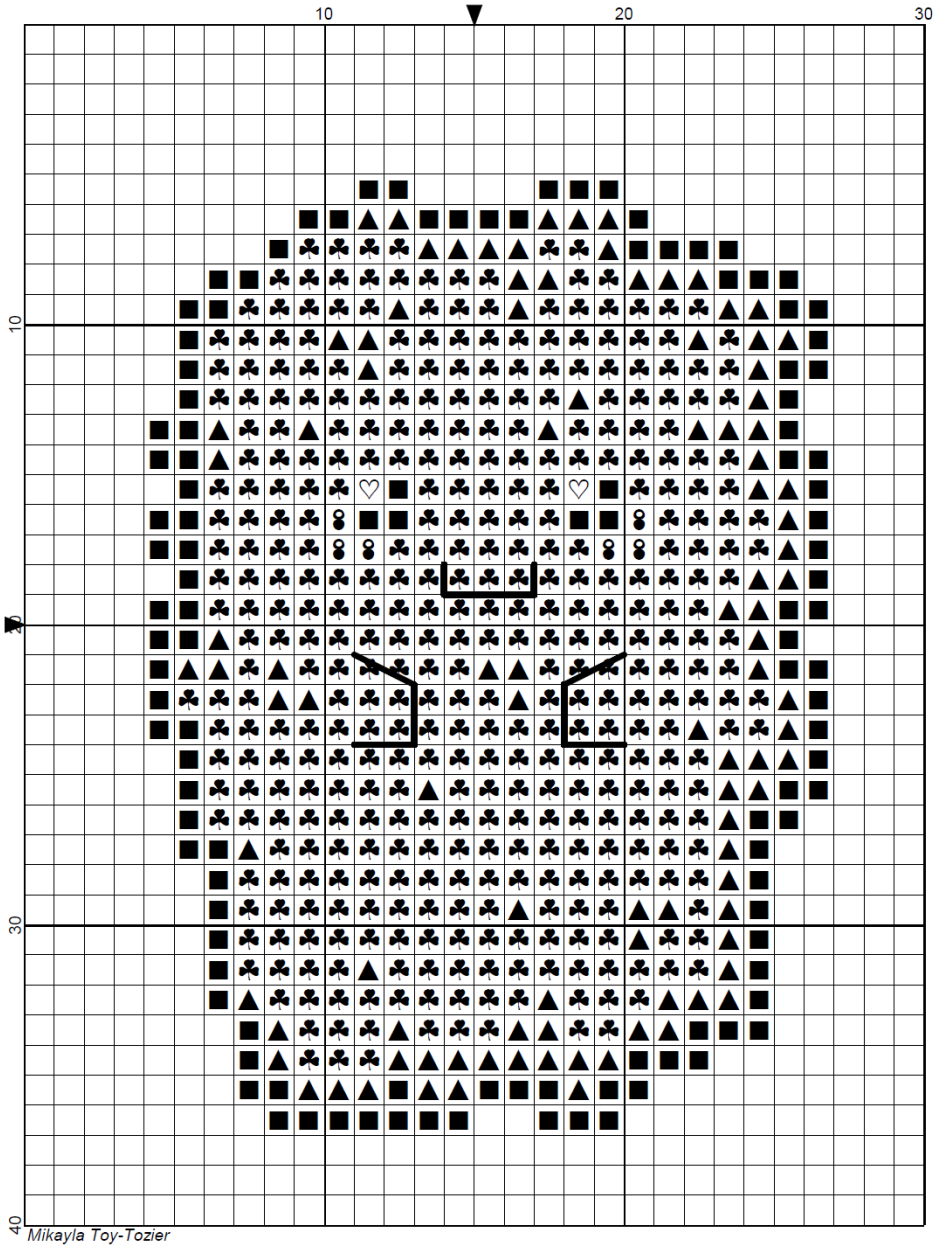

Extra Stuff!

For this project, I used 14 count white Aida cloth, while utilizing three strands to get extra coverage. You can use less strands; its all up to personal preference! For the blended entry, I chose to use one strand of DMC floss 3852 and two strands of DMC 420. I wanted a smooth crossover between the colors without losing the obvious darkness the 420 floss provided.
